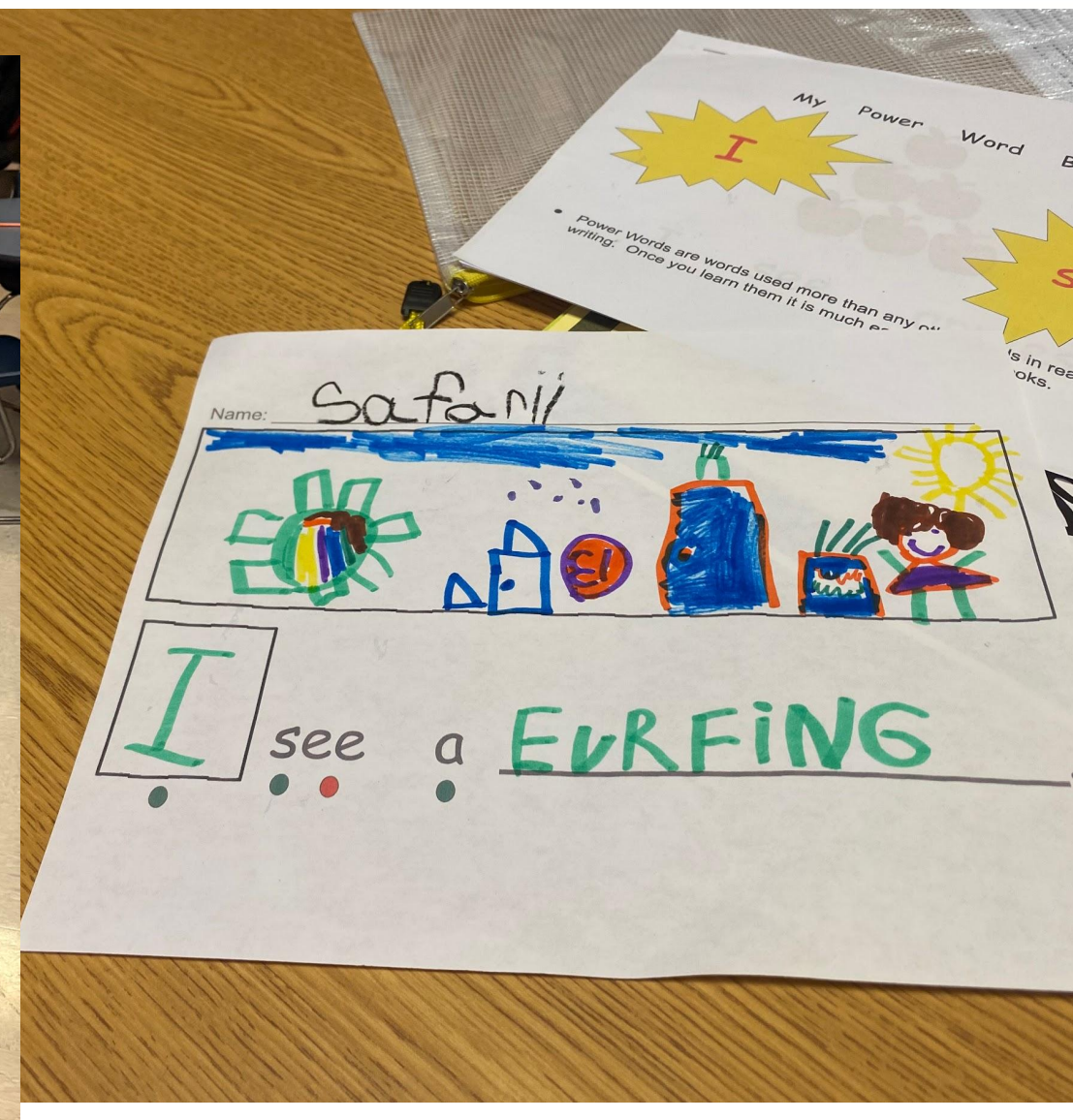
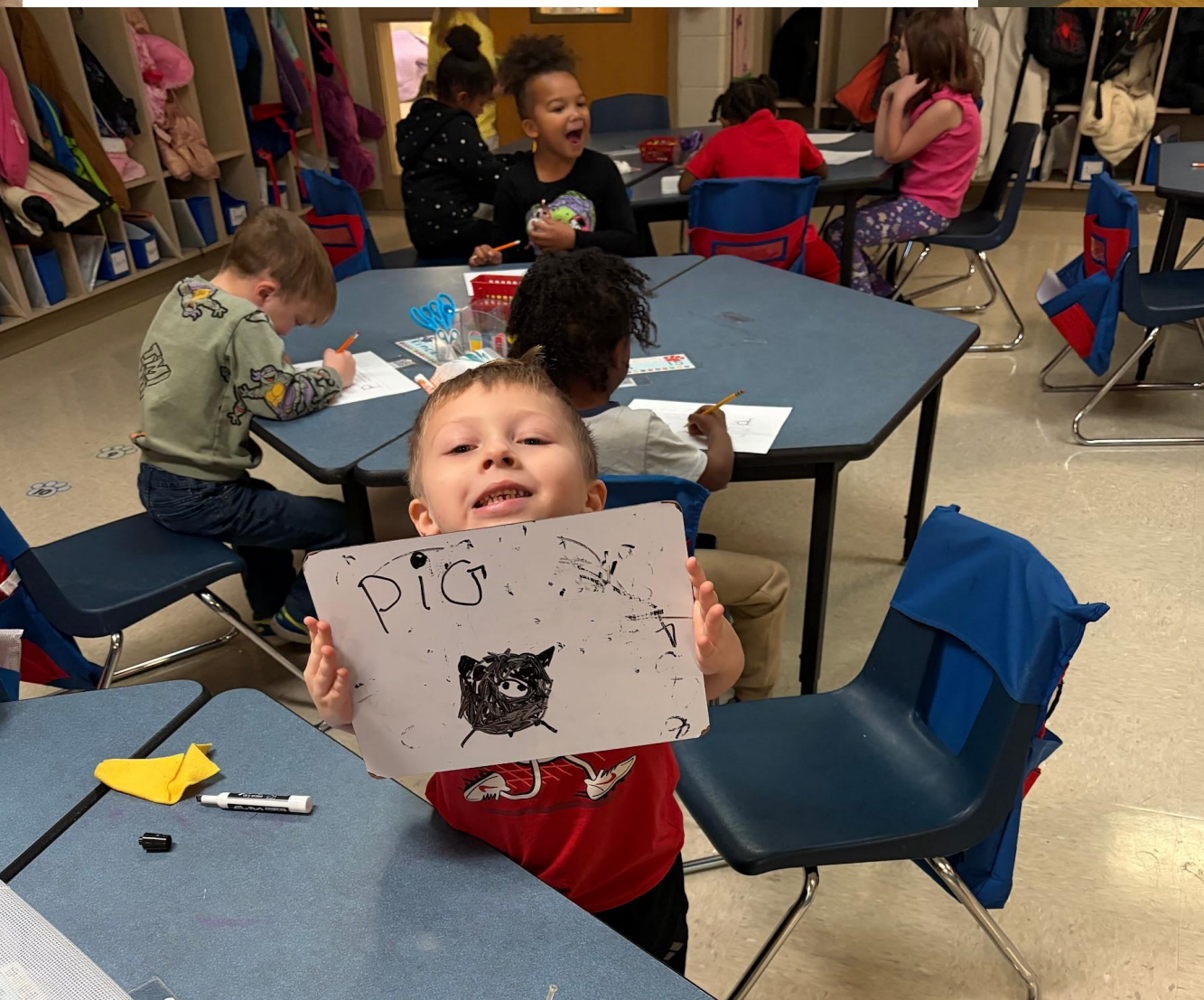
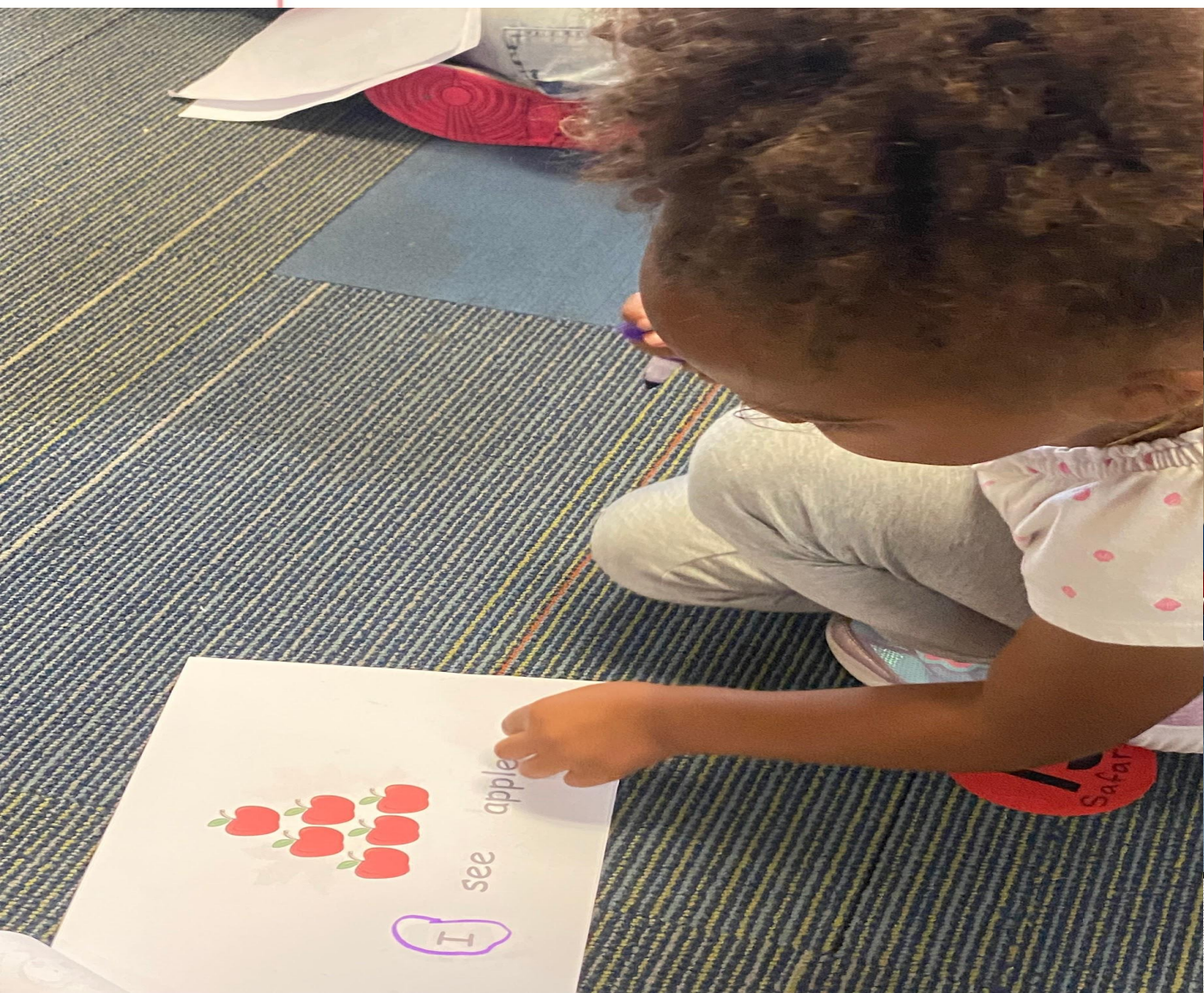
This week we started measuring things with non-standard units. We measured our feet and compared them to other friends in our classroom!





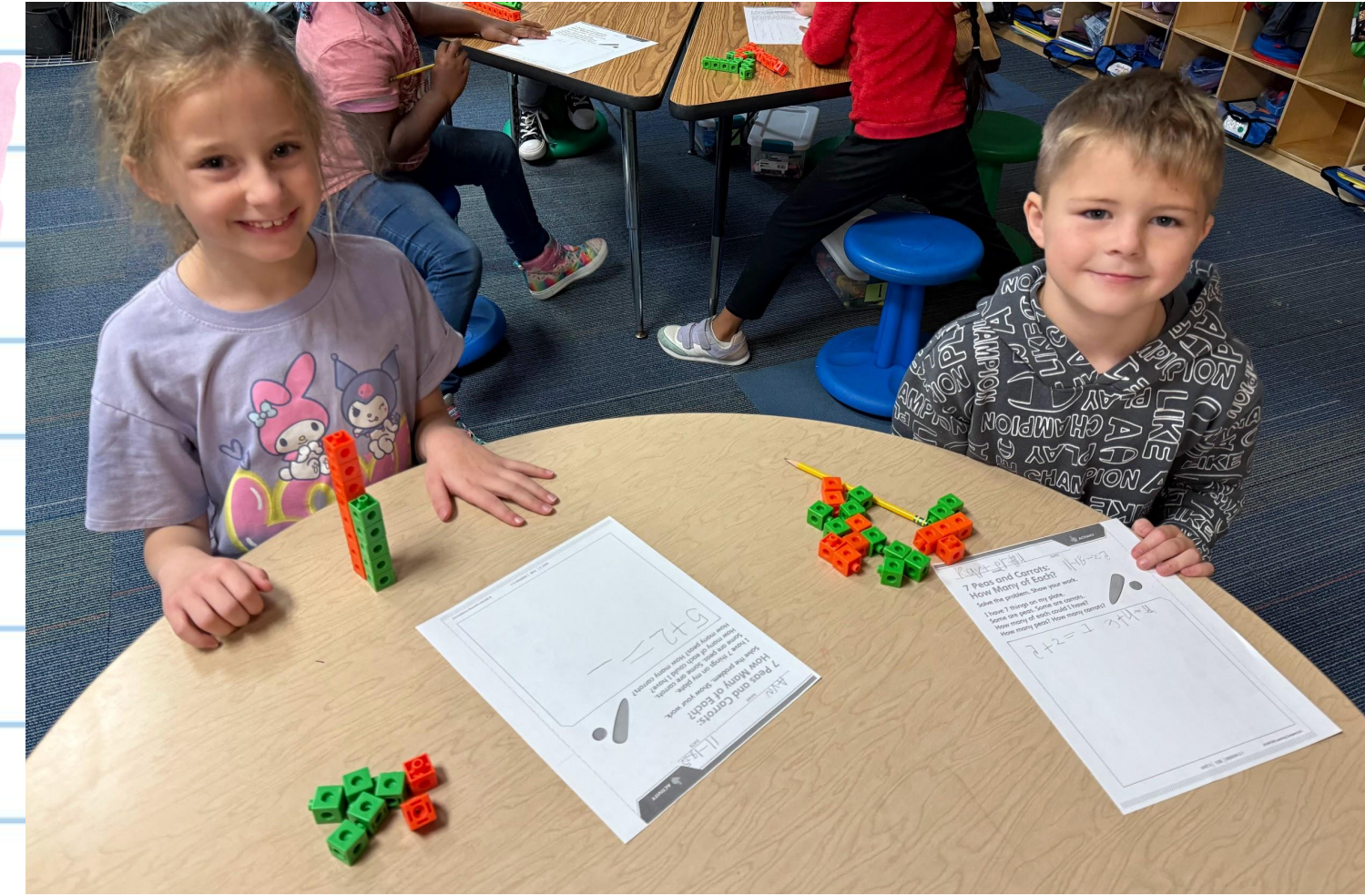

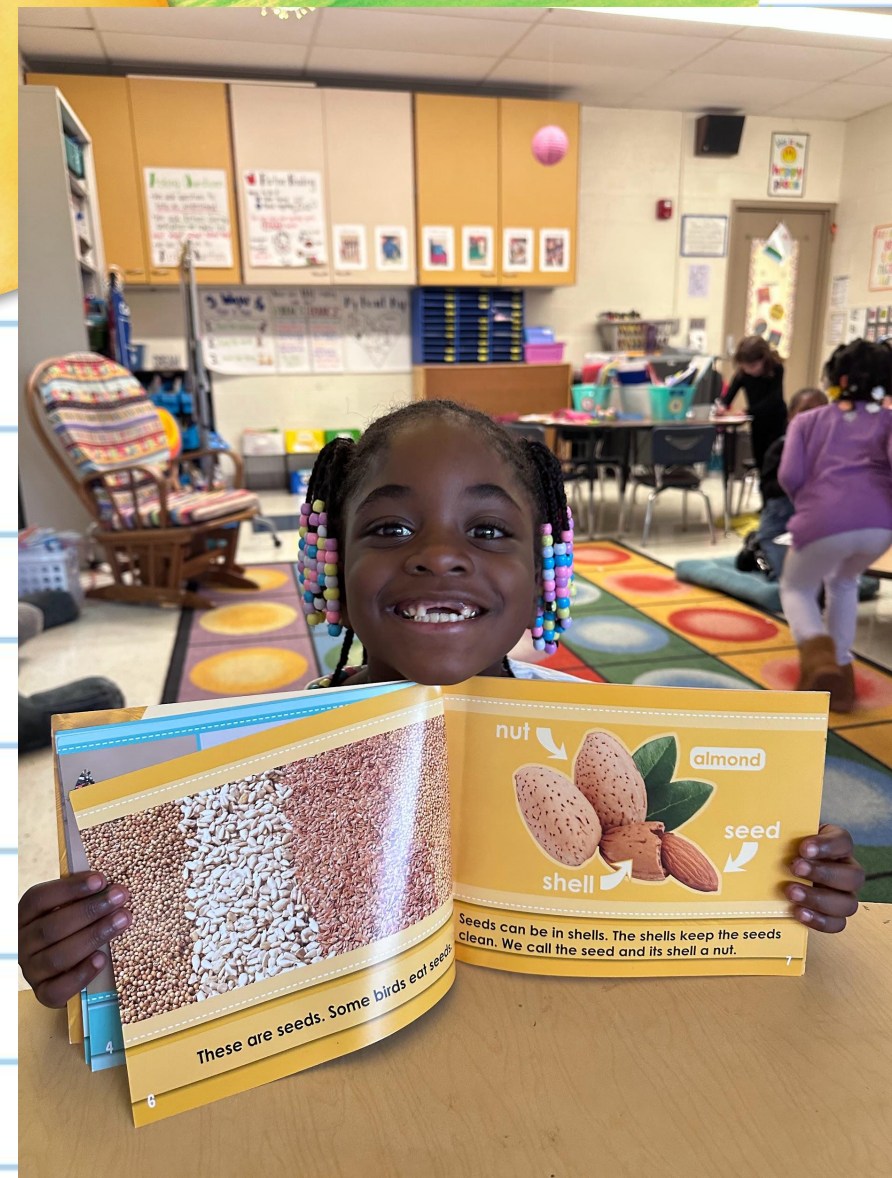


In math this week, we were learning how to find different combinations to make the same number.

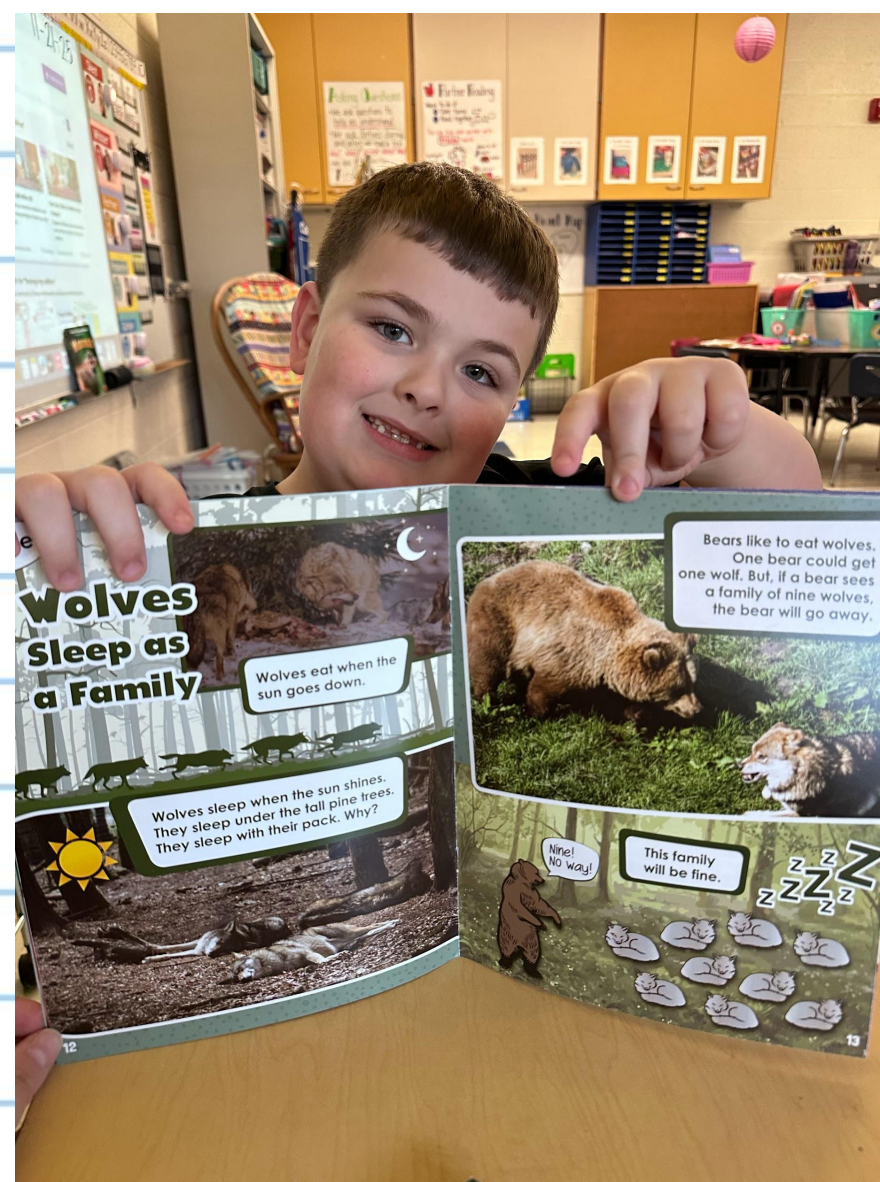

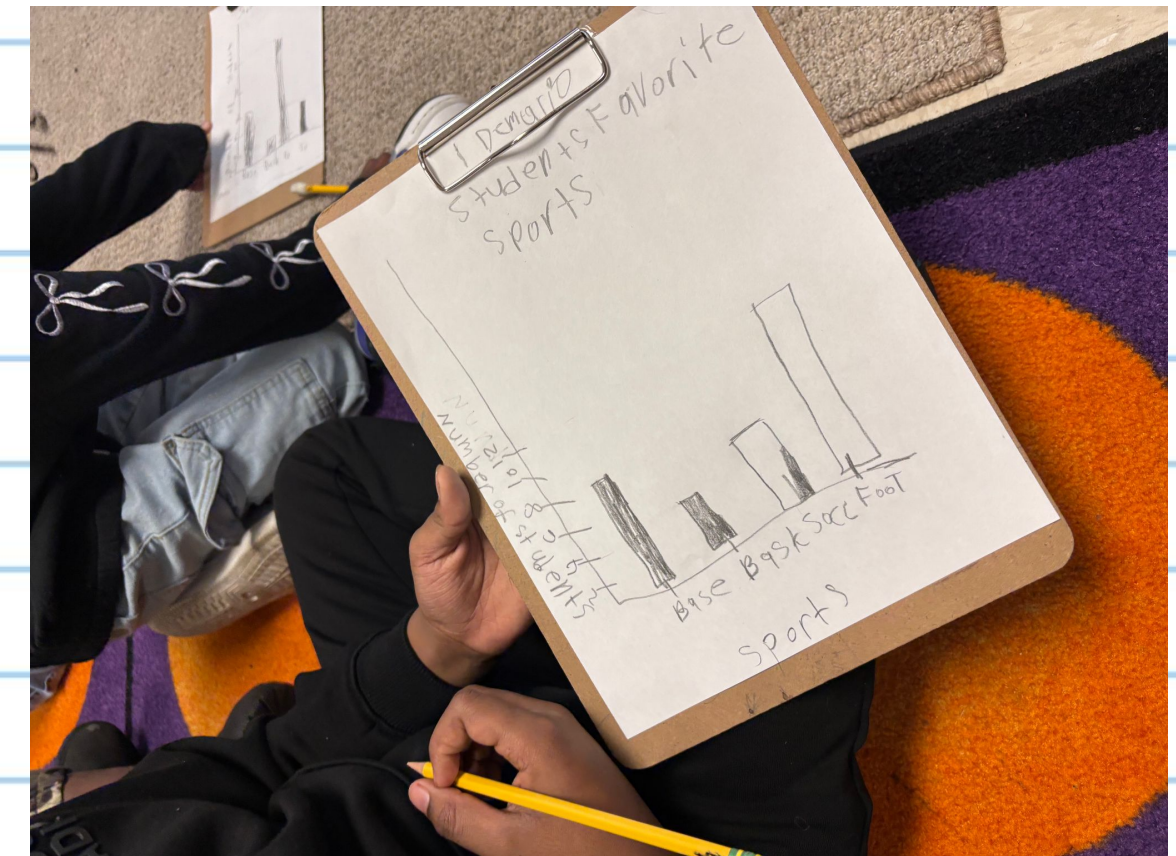
This week we have been building friendships in our room. We have been sitting and working together in smaller groups. We had media come in and read a book to us.

As well as sitting during sensory time working with kinetic sand.





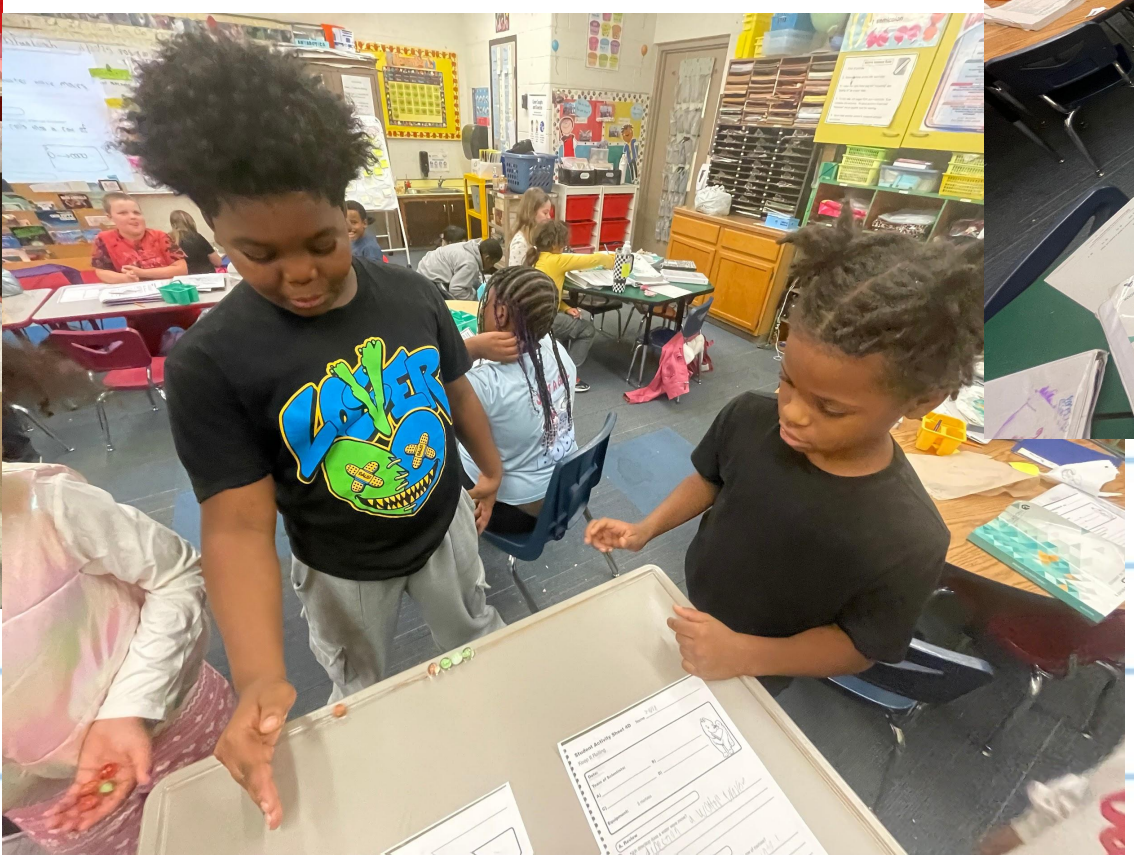
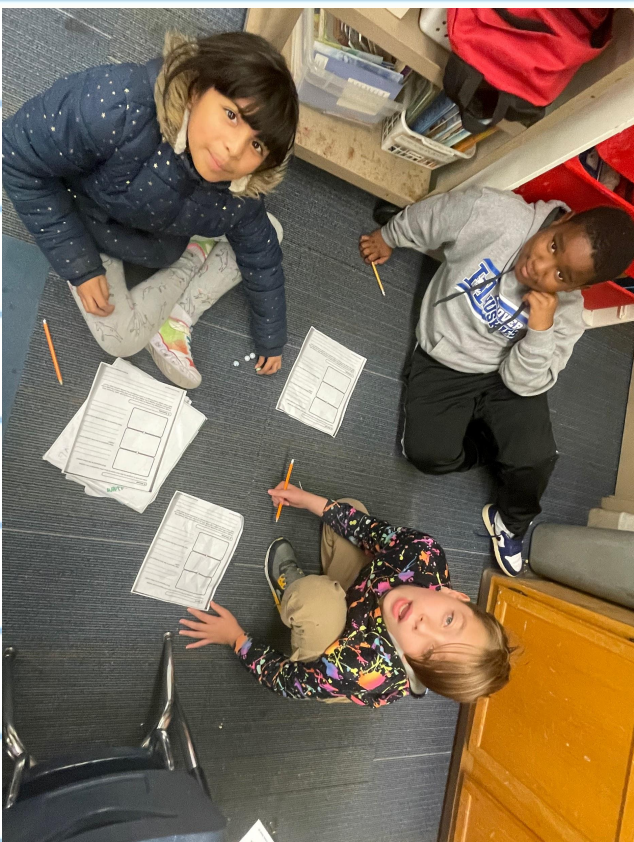
