


This week we began working with 2D shapes. We discovered that there are many different ways to solve shape puzzles!





Our class earned enough P.A.W. tickets to have a pajama/stuffed animal day. The students loved having their stuffie to learn with them today!!












Library came in this week to read us a story and do a craft. We loved participating in the craft. We got to use glue sticks during the craft. We sat really well during the story.

The students had a good time learning about measurement by measuring each others jumps and feet with a partner.







Mrs. Houston We are continuing our multiplication and division unit in math. We play math games every chance we get!
