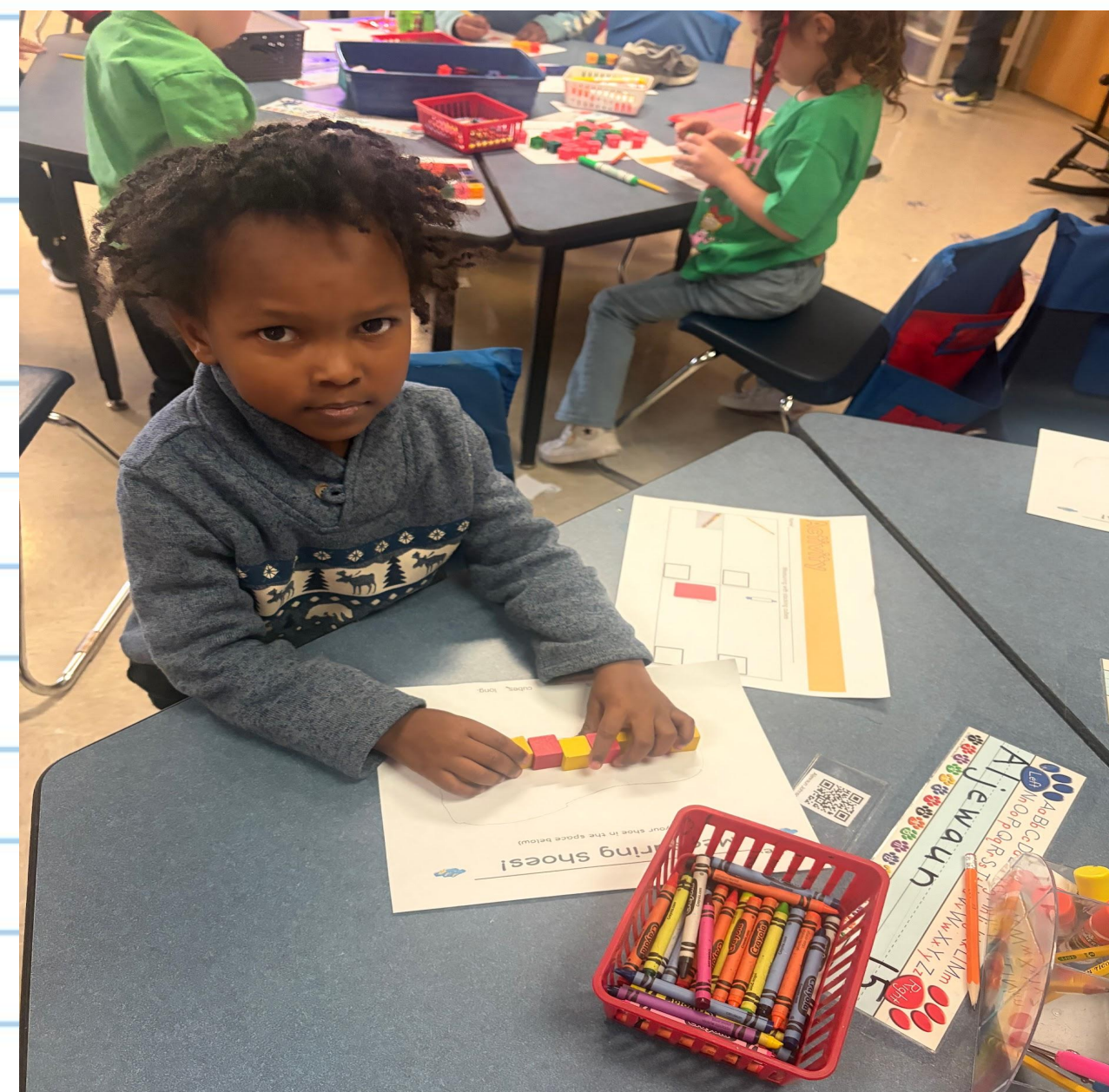
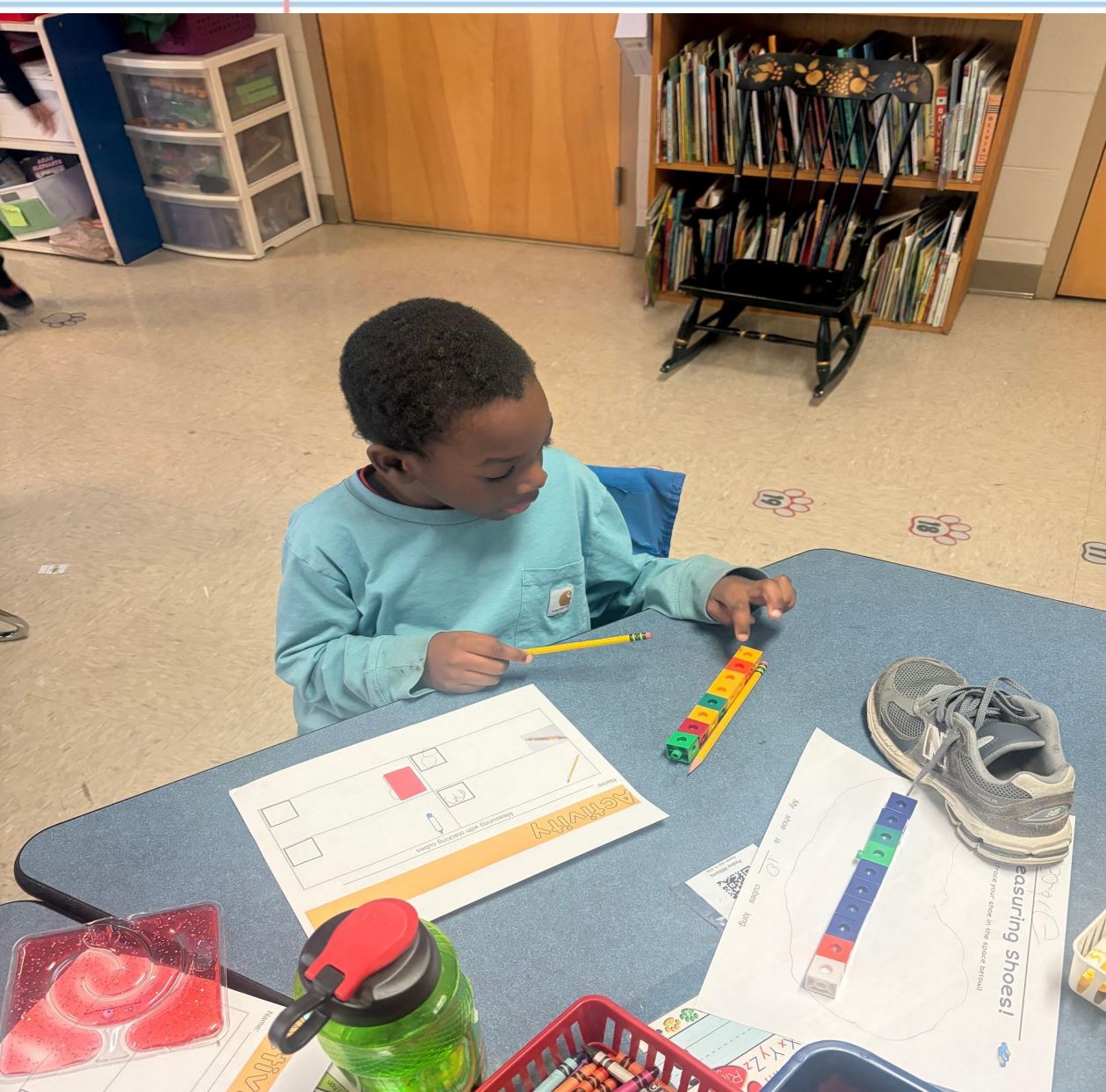
We had fun exploring math centers and measuring around the room with unifix cubes!

at the holiday concert!



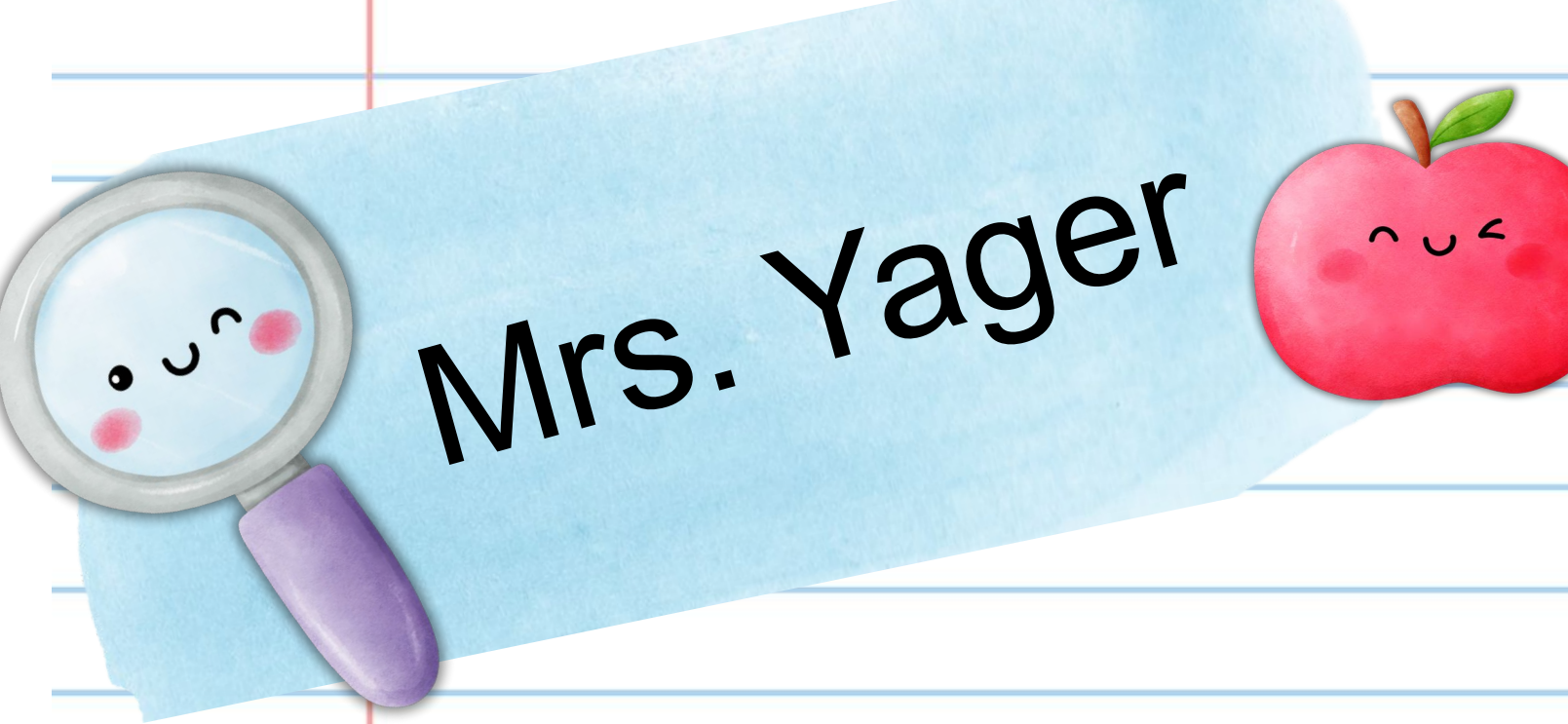

This week students built numbers with base ten blocks. Once they were able to build various numbers we used the base ten blocks to understand $+/ -$ tens and hundreds.

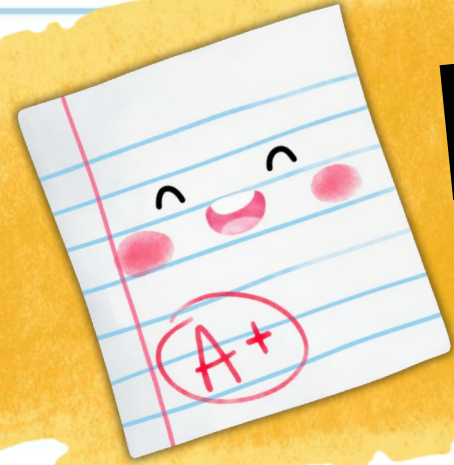

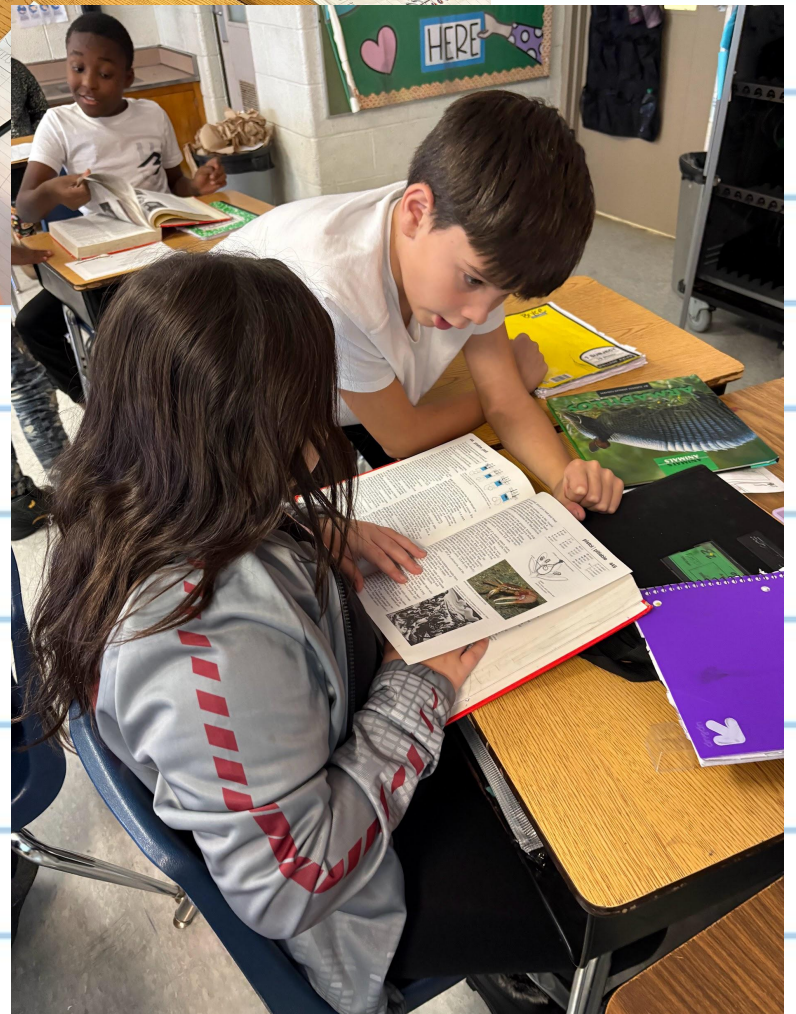
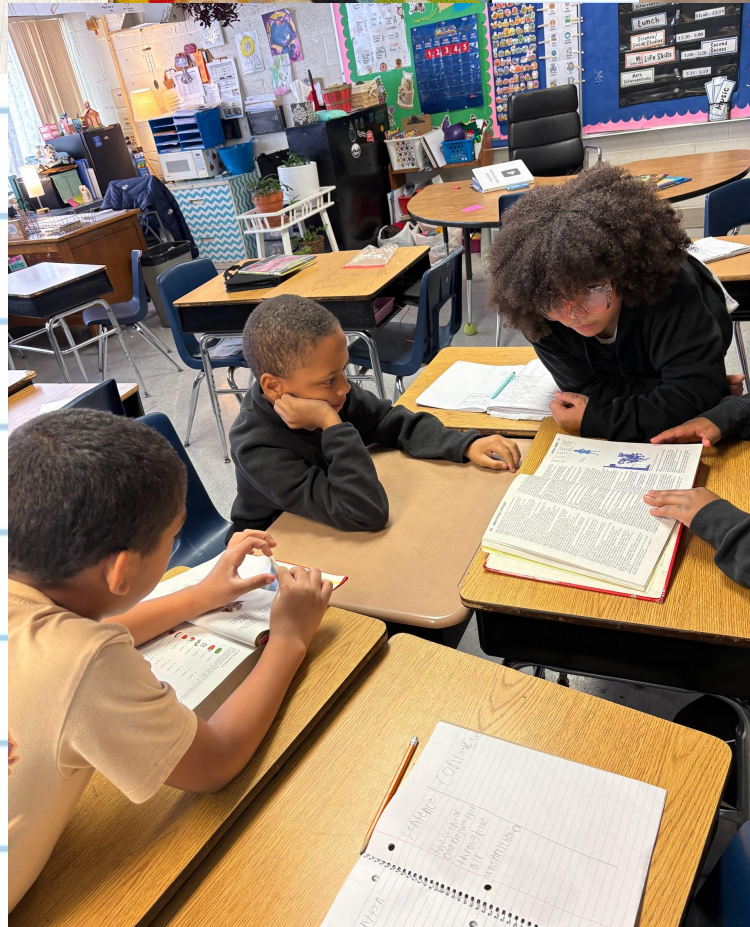
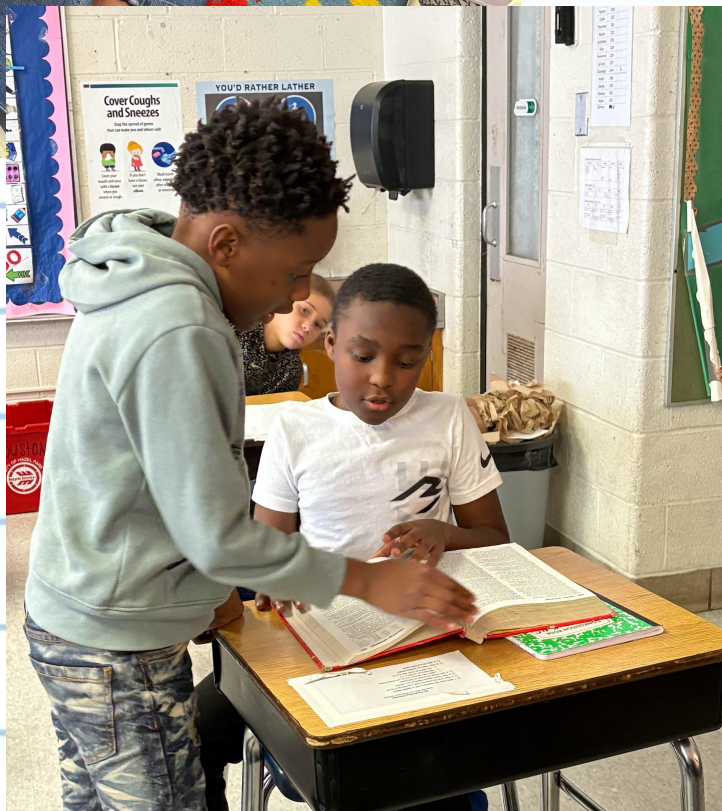
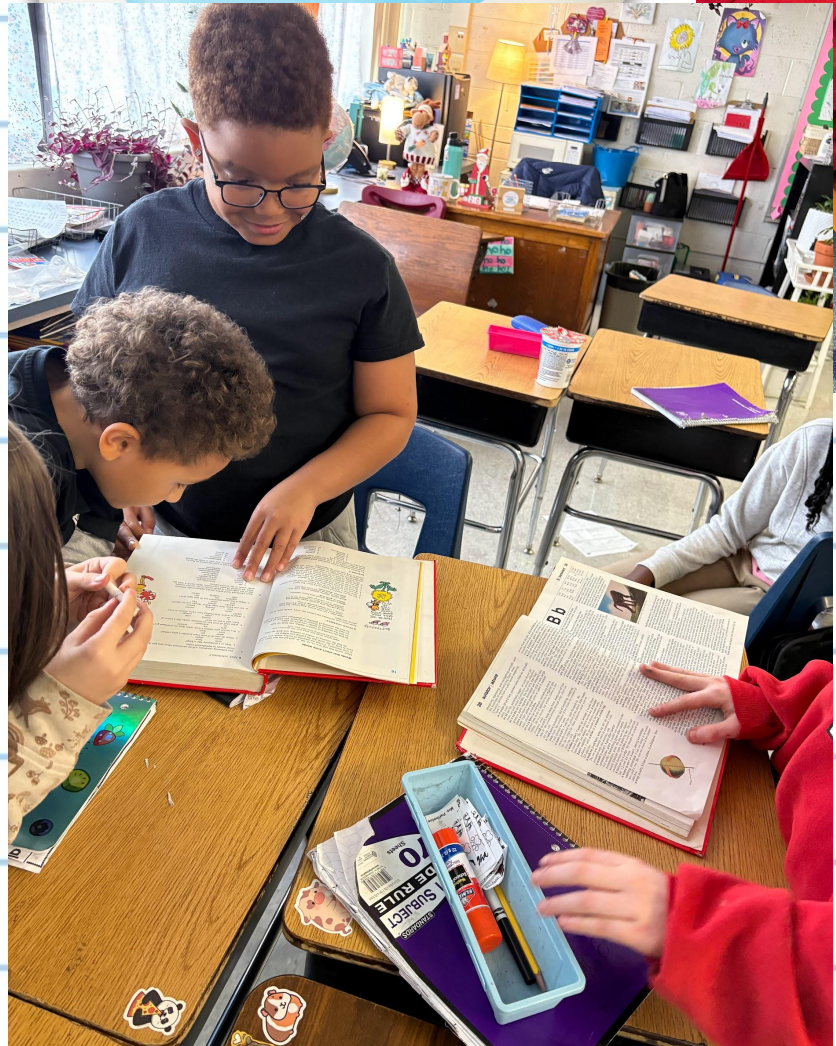
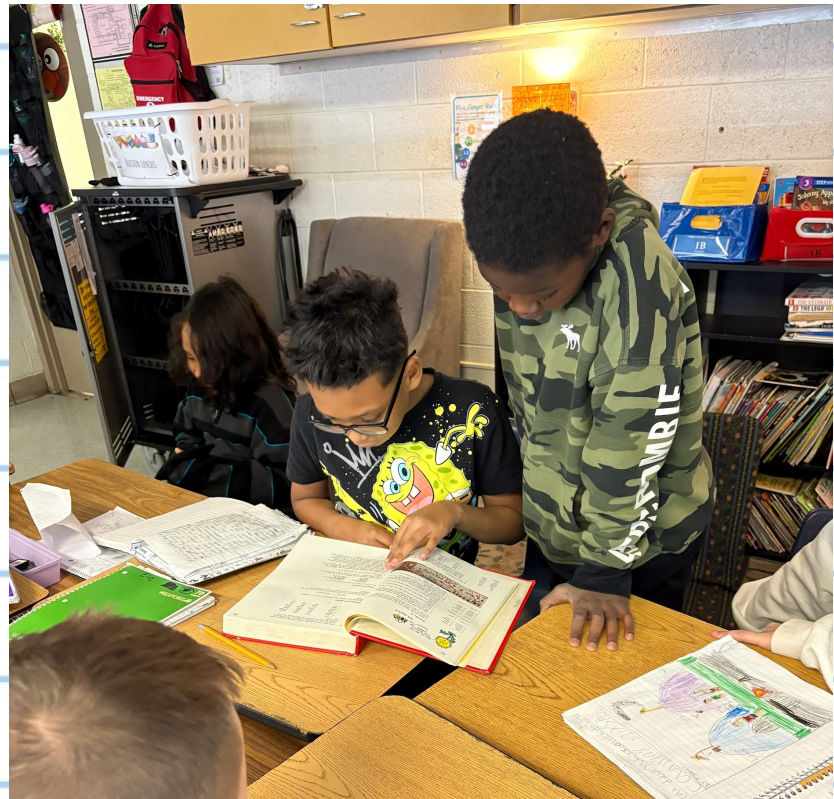


This week we spent time getting to know each other and learning how to interact with our classmates! A Play-Doh break did the trick!
