As always, please don't hesitate to reach out with questions, concerns, or celebrations. We love hearing about the successes our students are having both at school and at home.

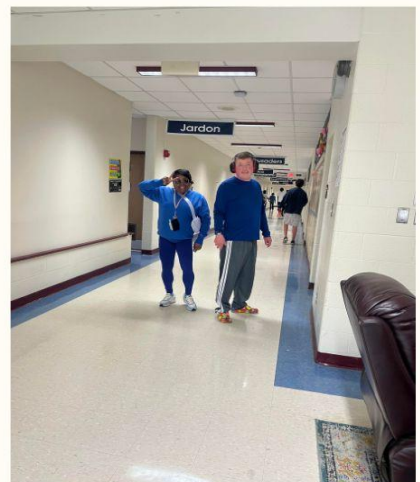

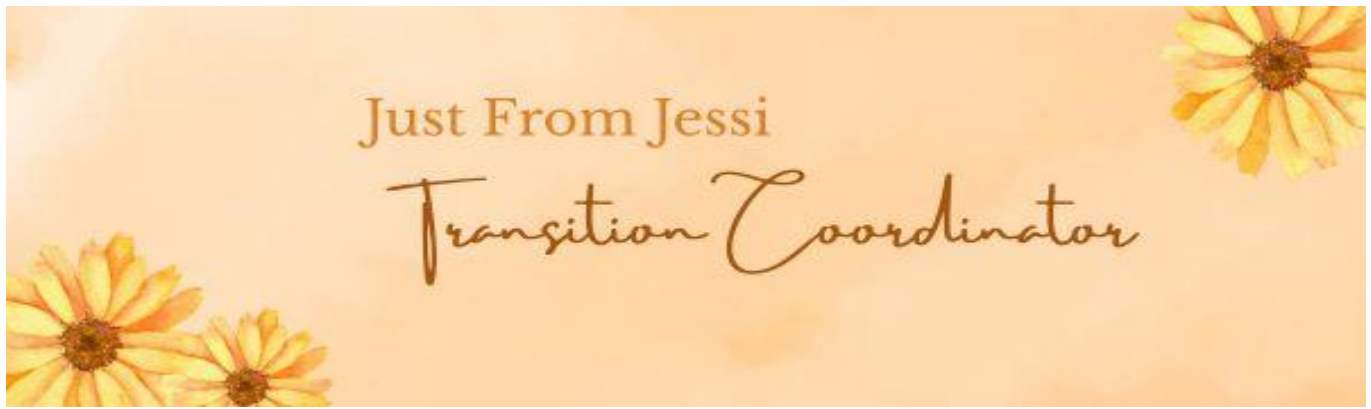

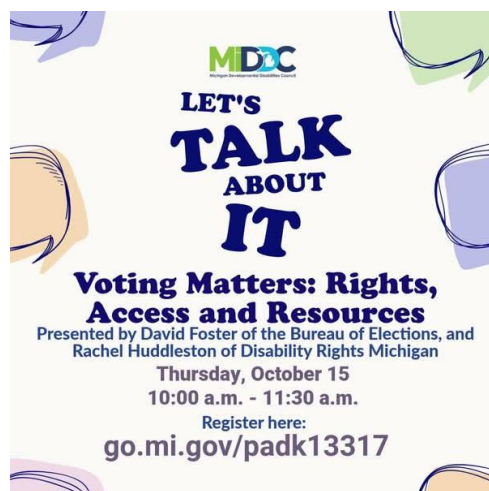
