Cold Weather

As we get closer to winter, we want to remind you about the importance of sending your child to school with warm jackets, etc. We try to go out for recess as much as possible so the students get some fresh air and exercise. The cutoff temperature is 20 degrees with wind chill factored in. Please make sure that your child brings appropriate gear to school to keep them warm during outside recess. If there is snow on the ground the students will ONLY be allowed to play on the playground if they have winter boots on. If they don't have boots they must stay on the sidewalk area. We do have some donated winter items if your child is in need - reach out to the school office to see if we have any items that would fit.

Holiday Baskets

We will again be collecting donations for Holiday Baskets at Webb. There is a district-wide effort to collect food for those in need. At Webb we will be collecting non-perishable potatoes - mashed, scalloped, etc. All donations can be sent in with your child to school. The winning classroom will receive a pizza party so be sure your child takes the items to the classroom to be counted first. If you are or know someone in need, applications to receive a holiday basket will be available in the school office starting November 3rd. At this time, holiday baskets are only given to those families that live within the school district, but out of district families can inquire about help as there are other resources in the community that we can connect you with.

Bagels

We sell bagels on WEDNESDAYS this year. We offer salt, plain, cinnamon raisin & onion. Students who are late will NOT be allowed to buy a bagel unless they have a doctor's note for their tardiness. The cost of the bagels is \$1.25. Please keep in mind that all proceeds from these sales support our positive behavior celebrations throughout the year.

Beetlejuice

For Hazel Park Drama's spring production—*Beetlejuice Jr.*, a wacky musical comedy—the high school drama department is inviting students in grades 4-8 to audition for our kid ensemble. That's right, your youngsters have the chance to perform alongside the high schoolers! They're holding auditions from 3:40 to 6 p.m. Tuesday, December 16, at Hazel Park High School. Forms will go home with students on Monday. Forms must be returned to the school office by 3 p.m. Wednesday, December 10, in order to participate in the audition. Bussing has been arranged for all interested students, with an after-school pickup from each school.





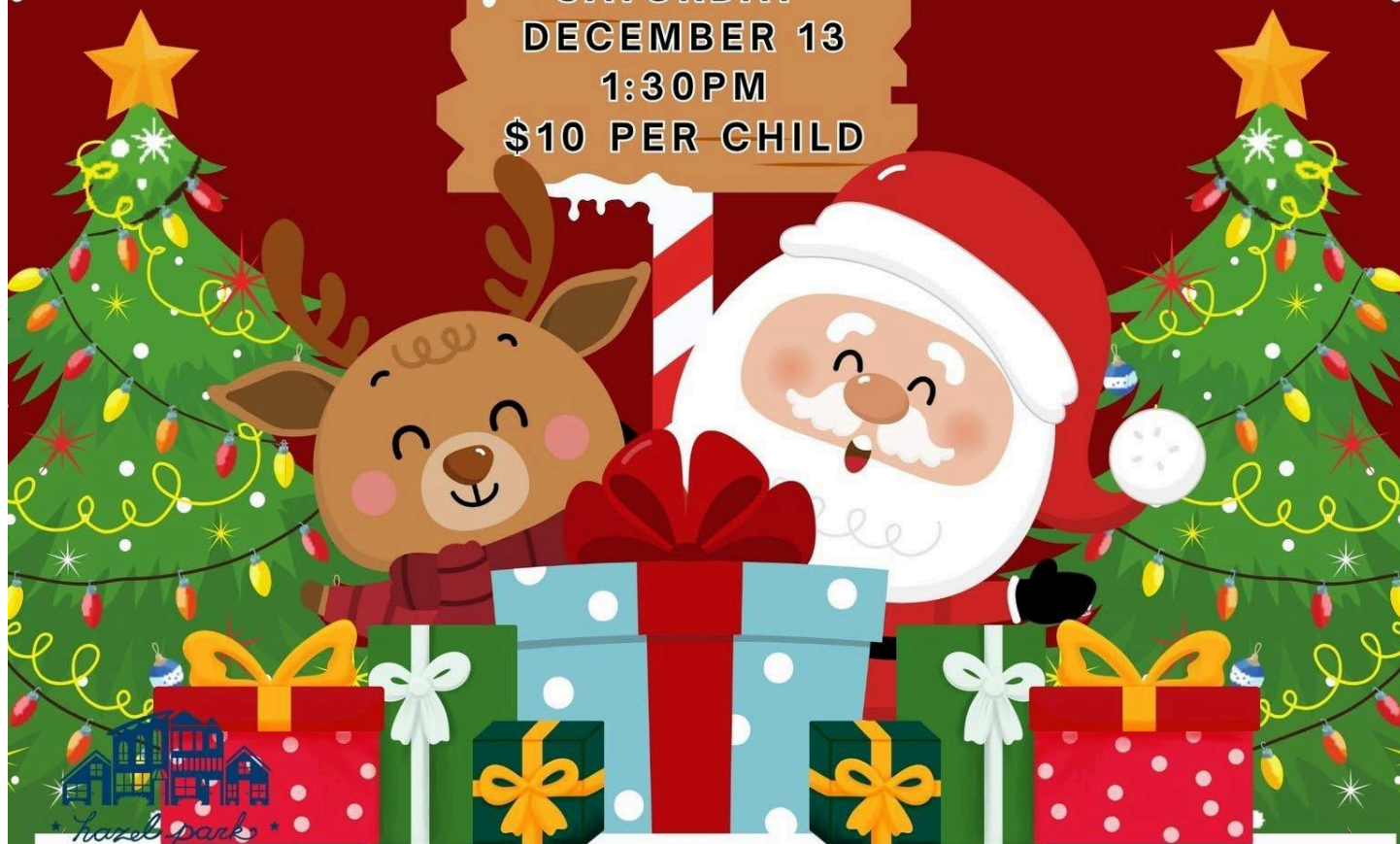
